Dear Families,

The month of February started with a BANG! We celebrated the Lunar New Year on February 1 which the children loved immensely. The day started with Mrs. Fujii, Ethan's grandmother in Orange Room, who did the Chinese cultural program for us. She provided the children with supplies to make a Chinese Lion with a paper bag. The children decorated their Chinese Lion puppet with colorful streamers and a lion face drawing which they colored.

Mrs. Fujii, dressed in her Chinese costume, started her presentation by greeting the children and teaching them Chinese words and phrases. She taught the children a Tai Chi dance and later performed a Tai Chi routine. She then read a story about the astrological tiger. To culminate this event, Mrs. Fujii played a recording of a Chinese Lion Dance Drumming as the children danced with the puppets that they created.

This experience was followed by food tasting which included gau, Chinese noodles, egg tarts, dim sum, rice cake, custard dessert, and manapua brought in by our families.

In the afternoon, Gee Yung Martial Arts Dragon and Lion Dance Association brought in two lions and performed their Lion Dance. The children especially enjoyed their dance as they were able to pet, touch and pose with the lion. We are grateful to this organization as this was the first lion performance at our preschool since the onset of COVID.

February was also our parent/teacher Zoom conferences. Thank you for attending these conferences. It is hoped that you learned more about your child's progress and what he/she is learning in school.

We look forward to the month of March as we plan for Japanese Culture Day. We will also have a one week break for Spring Recess and celebrate the Kuhio Day Holiday.

Although the COVID numbers are decreasing, our protocols will remain in place. We are guided by the Dept. of Human Services which has not loosened its restrictions on the preschools. We thank everyone for their patience and understanding as we realize the difficulties when classrooms are shut down. Each time we close down a classroom, we pray that COVID is contained and does not spread to others. Please know that our primary concern is the health and well-being of all of the children. However, each of us know that "We can do all things through Christ who strengthens us" (Philippians 4:13) and we are strengthened by our God that we trust.

Plans for the Summer

Please fill out the attached form if you plan to enroll in our summer session. The tuition can be paid in full by May 26 or in two increments (May 26 and July 1):

Toddlers: Full \$2095 by May 26. Two increments: \$1047.50 by May 26 and July 1
Preschool: Full \$1580 by May 26. Two increments: \$790 by May 26 and July 1

Both registration (\$50) and comprehensive fee (\$50) payments are due with the application.

Applications submitted after March 11 will include the application fee of \$50.

Open Doors Application

The Preschool Open Doors (POD) is sponsored by the Dept. of Human Services Benefit, Employment and Support Services Division. The application period is now opened until March 31, 2022. If your child was born between August 1, 2017 and July 31, 2018, your child is eligible to apply. This program helps eligible Hawaii families pay preschool fees for up to one year during the year prior to kindergarten entry. If you qualify, your application must be received by the office by March 31, 2022. Applications postmarked but not received by March 31 will not be considered. In the past, this program was very helpful to the families. For more information, please call 808 791 2130. Application forms are available at our preschool office.

 - A fee of \$25 will be assessed for each returned check. After the first returned check, payments must be made either in the form of cash, cashier's check or money order.
 - I understand that the registration fee is for summer only. The registration and comprehensive fees reserve a space for my child for the summer session. The comprehensive fee will cover the cost of supplies.
 - A late pick-up fee of \$10 per each 5-minute increment of delay after 4:30 p.m. will be assessed per child. There is no grace period.
 - Financial aid/scholarship recipients: In the event that monies have not been received by MCCP by the tenth of the month from funding agents (DHS, PKS, Alu Like, etc.), I / We will be responsible for full tuition payment.
 - I / We are financially responsible for the enrollment dates upon which childcare services have been agreed and understand that there are no refunds or reduction in tuition due to late entry, early withdrawal, extended absences due to family vacations and/or illnesses, or observed holidays.
